INTERNATIONAL BLOCK WEEK

A special week dedicated to welcoming visiting professors from around the world, fostering values of respect and openness to new perspectives.

Each semester our Faculty hosts distinctive seminars, where students take a break from their regular schedule to engage in projects, management games or study trips for one week.

The range of block weeks is as diverse as the lecturers themselves, offering the students the flexibility to choose topics of personal interest to broaden their horizon. You can find examples of successful topics on our website.

The collaborative experience of working in small groups (20 – 25 students) on diverse topics has received consistently positive feedback from both lecturers and students.

THE FRAMEWORK AT A GLANCE

Block weeks take place on:

- The last week of October
- The first full week in May

Timetable

As a visiting professor, you're required to teach 30 hours per week. While lecturers are not expected to teach all day, students should actively participate through group work, research, and presentations. Teaching hours are typically Monday to Thursday, 9am to 3:30pm, and Friday, 9am to 12pm.

The students

You will work with Bachelor students with diverse backgrounds from different study programs. The block week seminar is part of their curriculum, and they are required to attend regularly if they want to receive a “pass” grade and 2.5 ECTS credits.

OUR OFFER

Accommodation

Our aim is to ensure your stay is comfortable and convenient. In the summer term we organize accommodation in a hotel near the city center and in the winter term you will be accommodated in our guest house on Caprivi Campus.

Program for international guest lecturers

As part of your stay, the International Faculty Office arranges a program tailored to our international visitors, which facilitates interaction among our guests and our faculty.

Remuneration

For your seminar you will be paid a remuneration and receive a daily allowance. We cover your accommodation as well as travel expenses up to a fixed amount.

- May block week: December 1st
- October block week: May 1st
